Dear Mrs Majerczyk,

At Syngenta, our goal as a company is to help produce food for a growing global population in a sustainable manner. In so doing, we fully recognize the importance of constantly engaging with key stakeholders in order to better understand their concerns and in turn how we can better contribute to the needs of farmers, the demands of society and of course protecting the environment.
